Required Protective Gear for the Track and Gymkhana Events:

1. Full-coverage or three/quarter coverage DOT-compliant helmet (full coverage recommended)
2. Shatter-resistant eye protection
3. Sturdy over-the-ankle footwear (motorcycle-specific footwear recommended/high fashion heels not permitted)
4. Street motorcycle-specific jacket (denim jackets and non-motorcycle leather jackets are not allowed – armored jackets recommended)
5. Long non-flared durable motorcycle –specific pants, without any rips or tears
6. Full-fingered street motorcycle –specific gloves

Total Control will have motorcycle-specific jackets and pants available to borrow. Participants must provide the rest.

Basic dirt riding protective gear will be provided at the location for all participants in the Dirt Bike Training.
