What’s New?

- **Blended Course Structure!** The new course is a mix of interactive online modules and two virtual instructor-led (VILT) sessions.
- **Content Tailored to You!** The interactive online modules are designed to provide all participants with foundational knowledge while also providing a customized path of learning that speaks to your background, needs, and concerns in the motorcycle safety field.
- **Network-Building, Realistic Team Activities!** In each of the two virtual instructor-led sessions, each participant will complete activities with a mix of participants from across the motorcycle safety community. The scenarios used within the activities were designed with experts in the motorcycle safety field.

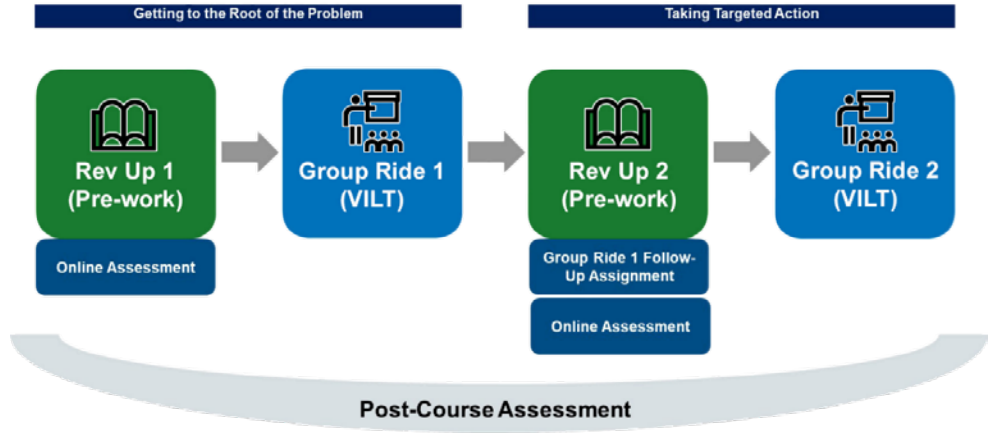
Getting to the Root of the Problem
